During this school year, a Nurse from Kenosha County Division of Health will be providing a fun and educational program on Asthma Education. This program will happen during the school day for students diagnosed with Asthma in grades 6<sup>nd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>. It will consist of four sessions lasting approximately 20-30 minutes during their lunch period. Parent involvement will include three follow-up phone calls to discuss the child's specific asthma control. We also provide a home visit for an environmental assessment, if requested by the parent.

The program is called Kickin' Asthma and it teaches kids with asthma about asthma symptoms, asthma treatment, and asthma medication using a multimedia curriculum. Kickin' Asthma is independently produced and was created by the American Lung Association.

Our records indicate that your child has asthma, and he/she will be invited to the session at Lance on the following dates: Tuesday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, Wednesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>, Tuesday, May 9<sup>th</sup> and Thursday, May 11<sup>th</sup>
